Passion and Knowledge

Romans 10:1-4

Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. ² For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. ³ For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. ⁴ For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Fences

- Paul again opens up about his desire for his fellow Israelites to be saved – 10:1 Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.
- They have a passion for God without an accurate knowledge of God – 10:2 For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.

Then (Pharisees): God's Word is so supreme that I need to create a system of laws to fortify God's Word and punish those who disagree.

Now (Sexually confused totalitarianism): My feelings/urges are so supreme that they cannot be questioned. Therefore, I need to create a system of laws to fortify what I feel and punish those who disagree.

Judges 21:25 In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.

 They built a system – 10:3 For, being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness.

Q: How did they build their religious system?

- o Willful rejection of the Truth.
- Seeking to put into force their own standard.
- Refusing to submit to God's standard.
- They missed the point of everything 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Religious fences that keep people from Jesus Christ

- Gotta do your part: My work + Jesus' work.
- Family tradition: Family's word over Jesus' Word.
- Be nice & don't judge...and that's it: Apostate church leader's word over Jesus' Word

Non-religious fences that keep people from Jesus Christ

- Paper-thin philosophical arguments.
- Love of money.
- Sexual anarchy and intolerant intolerance.
- People pleasing (fear of man vs. fear of God).

Matthew 6:33-34 But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

34 "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.
