Habakkuk 2:1-4

Waiting on God

- Look with expectancy instead of sitting in cynicism. 2:1 *I* will take my stand at my watchpost and station myself on the tower, and look out to see what he will say to me, and what I will answer concerning my complaint.
- Be open to surprises 2:2 And the Lord answered me: "Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it.

"The men doing vital things of life are those who read the Bible."

- Slow doesn't mean No 2:3 For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end—it will not lie. If it seems slow, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay.
- Pride puffs up but is powerless 2:4a "Behold, his soul is puffed up; it is not upright within him,
- Live fueled by faith in Jesus Christ 2:4b *but the righteous shall live by his faith*.

What is faith?

- Faith is not checking your brain at the door.
- Faith is not burying your head in the sand.
- Faith is a gift from God that we deploy by trusting Him.
